# Prestigious US magazine features Sligo tour group

**S**ligo-based tour group Seatrails are set to feature in this week's online copy of National Geographic.

Auriel Robinson, a guide who offers walking tours among other outdoor activities in Sligo and Leitrim, explained to the Sligo Weekender what the story will highlight.

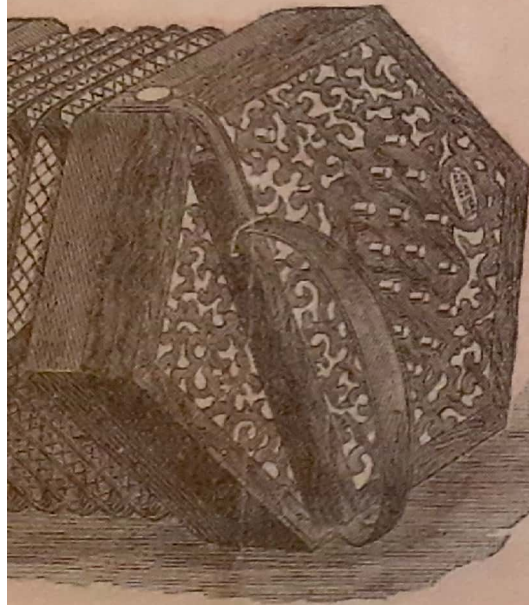
Seatrails are also actively involved in this week's Fleadh Cheoil and have confirmed details for a Spanish Armada Tour.
